The Homewood Flossmoor transition to Hammond water is going well at a 25% feed rate which equates to 400,000-500,000 gallons per day. The transition will increase to 50% on August  $16^{th}$  for 3 weeks then 75% on September  $13^{th}$  and 100% on October  $4^{th}$ .
